

**HEARING UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE REGISTRATION OF ENGINEERS ACT  
1967 AGAINST Ir. DAVID WONG TAI WOUI  
(P.E. NO.: 6884)**

**RESPONDENT:** Ir. David Wong Tai Woui (P.E. No. 6884)

**CHARGE 1:** *“That you, Ir. David Wong Tai Woui (P.E. No. 6884) (NRIC No.: 601111106371) of D.W. Perunding, a registered Professional Engineer engaged as the Structural Engineer for a 1½ Storey Shop Office Development in Melati Square Putra Nilai, PT No. 12286, H.S.(D): 92477, Mukim Labu, Putra Nilai, Negeri Sembilan Darul Khusus, had failed to discharge your professional duties with due skill, care and diligence in designing the ground slab as supported on grade despite the characteristic/nature of the soil/site, therefore causing the ground floor slabs to settle after the completion and thus contravened Section 15(1)(o) of the Registration of Engineers Act 1967. Such contravention being punishable under Section 15(1) read with Section 15(1A) of the Registration of Engineers Act 1967”.*

**CHARGE 2:** *“That you, Ir. David Wong Tai Woui (P.E. No. 6884) (NRIC No.: 601111106371) of D.W. Perunding, a registered Professional Engineer engaged as the Structural Engineer for a 1½ Storey Shop Office Development in Melati Square Putra Nilai, PT No. 12286, H.S.(D): 92477, Mukim Labu, Putra Nilai, Negeri Sembilan Darul Khusus, had failed in your responsibility to your employer, client or engineering profession to have full regard to the public interest in designing the ground slab as supported on grade despite the characteristic/nature of the soil/site, and therefore contravened Regulation 24 of the Registration of Engineers Regulations 1990. Such contravention being punishable under Section 15(1) read with Section 15(1A) of the Registration of Engineers Act 1967”.*

**HEARING:** Held at 9:00 am on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2012 at Bilik Mesyuarat Utama, BEM, Tingkat 17, Ibu Pejabat JKR, Jalan Sultan Salahuddin, Kuala Lumpur.

**DECISION:** The Disciplinary Committee finds Ir. David Wong Tai Woui (P.E. No. 6884) (NRIC No.: 601111106371) guilty of both Charges.
